

TRICARE INSURANCE

ELIGIBILITY

Upon reaching the age of 60, you are eligible for TRICARE INSURANCE.

There are several options: Contact the Military Personnel Office for information re: Tricare Benefits.

TRICARE FOR LIFE INSURANCE:

At the age of 65 years, the Retiree needs to bring the Medicare card into a DEERS/ID card section and get a new card issued. The front of the card is INDEF, but the back of the card will have an expiration date of the month before the 65th birthday. Once the Medicare is inputted into DEERS, the new card will have an INDEF on the back as well. (Tricare for life) The retiree will no longer have to get a new card; it will be valid for life.

The Medicare works the same way for Spouses. When they reach the age of 65 years, the Spouse needs to bring in the Medicare card and get a new card issued. The Spouse's card will be valid every four years until the age of 75 years, and then it will be INDEF.
